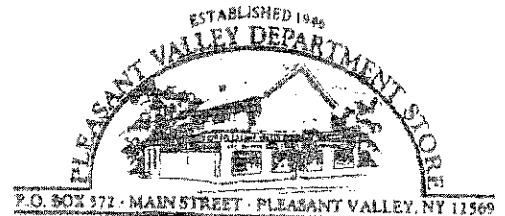
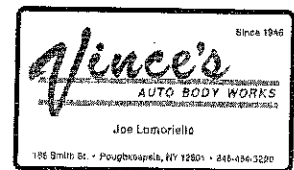

to aid the blind and visually handicapped through sponsorship of a Bike Ride. The Lions Club will sponsor free eye examinations, provide glasses to the needy, donate large-print books and other materials to individuals and libraries and make available mobility aids such as white canes and dog guides. The Bike Ride will raise much-needed funds to continue this and other important work in the community.

Bike Rides are open to all interested participants 8 years of age and older. Children 8-11 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. Children 14 years or younger must wear a helmet. Helmets strongly recommended for others. \* **Minimum Contribution is \$10.**

Milestone Square (ACME) Shopping Center at the intersection of Route 44 (Main Street) and North Avenue, Pleasant Valley, New York.

The ten mile ride will be a scenic, traffic-free ride through the back roads and farmlands of Pleasant Valley and Salt Point. The course begins at the intersection of Route 44 and North Avenue, goes north to Salt Point, west along Salt Point Road to Sherow Road and back to North Avenue to the Town Recreation Park, behind Town Hall on Route 44.

The more serious 25 mile ride will wind north of Salt Point into the Town of Clinton before turning to the Pleasant Valley Recreation Park.

Obtain as many sponsors as you can and collect money in advance if possible. Ask your sponsors to clearly print their name, address and pledge per mile.
