

**TOWN OF PLEASANT VALLEY**

**LOCAL LAW NO. X OF THE YEAR 2015**

A Local Law of the Town of Pleasant Valley, New York to Repeal Local Law X of 2014 adopted by Resolution No. 142/2014 to Override the Tax Levy Limit for Fiscal Year 2015 as established in General Municipal Law § 3-c.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Town Board of the Town of Pleasant Valley as follows:

**Section I: Title.**

This Local Law shall be known and cited as Town of Pleasant Valley “Local Law No. X of the Year 2015, to Repeal Local Law X of 2014 Adopted by the Town of Pleasant Valley by Resolution No. 132/2014 to Override the Tax Levy Limit for Fiscal Year 2015 Established in General Municipal Law § 3-c.”

**Section II: Legislative Intent.**

The Town Board of the Town of Pleasant Valley adopted a budget for 2015 that did not require a real property tax levy in excess of the “tax levy limit” as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-c therefore it desires to repeal the Local Law as it is no longer necessary.

**Section III: Repeal**

Local Law No. X of 2014 adopted by Resolution No. 142/2014 is hereby repealed effective immediately.

**Section IV: Severability.**

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

**Section V: Effective Date.**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
