**TOWN BOARD RESOLUTION NO.: 131/2015**

**RE: KENNETH M. PEABODY D/B/A ROADHOUSE - LIQUOR LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, Kenneth M. Peabody D/B/A Roadhouse submitted a Notice of Intent to file a renewal application for an On-Premises Alcoholic Beverage License for “liquor, wine and beer” to be sold at 1631 Main Street, Pleasant Valley, New York; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Alcohol and Beverage Control Law Section 110-b, Subdivision 1(b), the Town has been notified of their intent to file an application for a liquor license renewal with the New York State Liquor Authority; and

WHEREAS, a thirty (30) day hold before said application can be filed is mandated by New York Alcohol and Beverage Control Law, however, this time period may be waived by the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to assist the applicant in expediting the application process so as to allow the business to achieve the greatest level of success by advancing this approval process so that the current license does not lapse; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that to the extent permitted by the New York State Liquor Authority, the Town Board hereby waives the requirement that written notice of the application be given to the Town at least thirty (30) days prior to submitting this application; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized to issue a letter to the applicant and to the New York State Liquor Authority to confirm the Town’s receipt of the Notice of Intent to file for the liquor license renewal and a waiver of the thirty (30) day hold on the processing of said application.
