TOWN BOARD RESOLUTION NO.: 126/2016

RE: AUTHORIZING APPLICATIONS TO NEW YORK STATE’S CLIMATE SMART COMMUNITIES GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, New York State is offering funding for communities ready to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and prepare for the effects of climate change through the Climate Smart Communities Grant Program where Towns in the State of New York are eligible to receive funding and the Climate Smart Communities Grant Program will provide 50/50 matching grants for eligible projects; and

WHEREAS, grant funding maybe used for the implementation of activities that focus on decreasing community vulnerability in the face of a changing climate, including, but not limited to, the relocation or retrofit of climate-vulnerable facilities which provides for the strategic relocation of vulnerable municipal facilities or infrastructure and/or installation of measures to reduce climate risk, including but not limited to elevation of facilities and flood proofing; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pleasant Valley has been subject to flooding from the Wappinger Creek in recent years which has demonstrated the extreme vulnerability of municipal facilities and infrastructure, specifically Town Hall; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Pleasant hereby authorizes and directs the Town’s Supervisor to seek available funding from New York State through a Consolidated Funding Application for Climate Smart Communities Grants.
