TOWN BOARD RESOLUTION NO.: 197/2016

RE: REQUEST THAT NYSDOT CONDUCT TRAFFIC SIGNAL STUDY AT THE INTERSECTION OF ROUTE 44 AND ROUTE 82

WHEREAS, members of the Town Board have received numerous concerns and requests in regard to unsafe traffic conditions at the intersection of US Route 44 and NYS Route 82; and

WHEREAS, in particular, turning onto Route 44 from Route 82, during rush hours is extremely difficult and dangerous; and

WHEREAS, the intersection is located in the hamlet of Washington Hallow and directly at the intersection sits two retail plazas and New York State Police Troop K Headquarters; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the traveling public and for the general public health, safety and welfare that by this resolution, the Town of Pleasant Valley Town Board hereby requests that the NYSDOT conduct an engineering study of traffic conditions, pedestrian characteristics and physical characteristics of the intersection of US Route 44 and NYS Route 82 to determine whether installation of a traffic control signal is justified; and

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Pleasant Valley hereby authorizes and directs the Town Clerk provide a certified copy of this resolution to the NYS Department of Transportation, Region B, Todd Westhuis, P.E., Regional Director and Adam Levine, P.E., AICP Regional Traffic Engineer, 4 Burnet Boulevard, Poughkeepsie, NY 12603 and the Town Clerk and the Town Supervisor be authorized to take any additional action or provide additional information as may be necessary to effectuate the terms of this resolution.
